Sub:- All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) – Uploading of data for the year 2018-19 – Reg.

As you are aware, “All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE)” is portal based survey, the initiative of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, in which with your participation, data are uploaded on AISHE portal by all the Higher Education Institutions. For current year, AISHE 2018-19 survey was started **and AISHE portal will remain open till 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2019**. So, you are requested to upload your Institute Information for AISHE 2018-19 on AISHE portal before 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2019 to avoid last minute network traffic rush.

University Grants Commission (Furnishing of Information by Universities), Rules 2015 stipulates that ultimate responsibility of timely uploading of the data annually on All India Survey on Higher Education portal in respect of University shall be of the Registrar. AISHE guidelines provide that if any College fails to upload its data, Nodal Officer should make arrangement for collection and uploading of data. The Ministry made it abundantly clear that the Government would be constrained to withhold central grants if uploading of the data on AISHE portal by the institutions is not completed in the stipulated period.

In this connection, I request you to kindly direct University Colleges and also affiliated Colleges under your jurisdiction to upload AISHE data on or before 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019.

Please consider the above matter as very serious and put all the efforts to ensure uploading of data by all the affiliated Colleges under the University jurisdiction without fail, otherwise, the Government may take action in terms of UGC rules said above.
