Apart from TV broadcast, the viewing facility may also be arranged through Edusat and also on internet access devices. For very remote areas where arrangement of TV viewing facility is not possible, radio / transistors through which the school children may listen to the Prime Minister's interaction may be arranged.

2. I, therefore request you to make all necessary arrangements in Universities / Private Universities / Govt. / Aided/ Un-Aided/ Private Colleges and Govt., & Private Schools to telecast of Hon'ble Prime Minister interaction with students.



3. You are kindly requested to attend this Video conference and to confirm the participation of the Minister, Education.

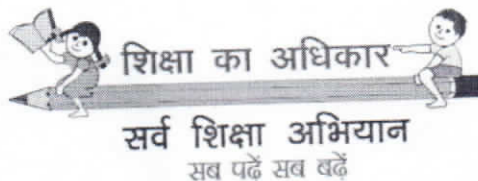

Dear Sir,

It is my pleasure to inform you that the Hon'ble Prime Minister will be interacting with students of schools and colleges on matters concerning how to reduce exam stress, on 16.02.2018. In this regard, a book, 'Exam Warriors', authored by then Hon'ble Prime Minister of India has been launched by the Hon'ble External Affairs Minister Smt. Sushma Swaraj in the presence of the Hon'ble Human Resource Development Minister Shri Prakash Javdekar on 3rd February, 2018.

2. The PM's interaction will be with school students from classes 6 upwards and will be from 11.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon. It will be broadcast live by Doordarshan through DD National, DD News and DD India. It will also be available through live airing on radio channels (All India Radio Medium Wave, All India Radio FM Channel), live web streaming on websites of PMO, MHRD, Doordarshan, MYGov.in and Youtube channel of MHRD, Facebook Live and Swayamprabha channels of MHRD.

3. You are requested to make necessary arrangements so that all the students from class 6 upwards in all schools in your State/UT can view/hear the telecast.


4. Although most schools are equipped with TV and have electric connection, in case electricity, TV and reception of TV signal (either through DTH satellite, cable or aerial antenna) is not available or in non working condition in the school, then action to ensure that arrangements for a TV and facility for TV reception (including making alternate arrangements for electricity that day through generators/inverters, etc.) to ensure that students can view/hear the Prime Minister's live address on that day may be taken in all schools under your jurisdiction.

5. Apart from TV broadcast, the viewing facility may also be arranged through Edusat, and also on internet access devices (computers/laptops/mobile, etc.). For very remote areas where arrangement of TV viewing facility is not possible, radio/transistors through which the school children may listen to the Prime Minister's interaction may be arranged. In the case of schools, States and UTs can utilize funds under the SSA, and RMSA for the purpose of hiring TVs, if required, and making necessary arrangements.

6. This may kindly be given TOP priority.
